The youngest children (Preschool ministry) will memorize one verse a month which will be the bold section, young children (K–1st grade) will memorize the underlined part of the verse. And the older children (2–6th) will memorize the entire passage. But we would encourage you to challenge your child to learn as much of the verse as possible, regardless of age, based on their individual ability.
